(Place Plans are part of the LDF and cover infrastructure requirements of each area focusing on what is needed to support development inc schools, highway issues, utilities etc.) 3 possible dates for the meeting are 18th, 25th April or 13th May.
- Futurefit Decision- On 29.1.19 RSH was agreed to become the Emergency Care Site to include a Critical Care Unit, Emergency surgery & medicine, Complex planned surgery & Womens/childrens consultant led inpatient services. PRH will focus on Planned Care to include Planned inpatient surgery, non-complex surgery, Breast inpatient services & medical wards. Both sites will have an Urgent Care Centre (A&E) open 24hr/7dys. £312m of funding will help to develop both hospitals to delivering state of the art facilities.
